



Kindergarten Supply List

This year for Kindergarten I am asking for <u>\$40</u> and I will buy the following items for the class: markers, pencils erasers, duotangs (report covers), glue, crayons, scissors, playdoh, Kleenex, plastic bags, markers, and a School Agenda. This can be paid either in cash or with a cheque made out to Turtleford School on the registration day or through cash online.

You will still need to buy/bring the following items.

1 set of **headphones** for the computer lab with a volume control (if possible but not necessary)

Velcro Gym shoes- with non-marking soles for gym and inside wear

Lunch box for snacks and lunches

Book bag – for beautiful and sometimes very large projects

An extra **change of clothes** (please send in a ziploc bag for storage with their name on the outside, and clothes labelled)

Paint shirt – A larger old shirt will suffice for this, or they can be purchased. Old shirts are great because they can be thrown in the laundry if need be. *Please write your child's name in the paint shirt.*

A **family picture** -4x6 if possible (or send me a copy)

Water bottle – to bring to school each day and take home to be washed

***Please print your child's name on all supplies and outerwear. ***

***Bring these items with you on the registration day in September. ***

Thank you for letting me spend some time getting to know your child a bit better. We are all excited about school in the fall!

Starting dates and information:

Individual Interviews (about 30 minutes per child)

- September 2nd and 4th
- We will schedule a time later in August.
- I take this time to get to know students a bit better.
- Students get to know me and the classroom a bit better.
- Parents are welcome to discuss any concerns, medical issues or anything that might be on your child's mind.
- Bring in labelled supplies and fees.

Half Class Days (I will bring in the class half at a time.)

- September 8th and 10th
- Students will be assigned a day to attend. We will schedule this later in August as well.

Our regular, every-other-day <u>of school</u> schedule will begin on September 12th. <u>Please</u> <u>note that this is every other STUDENT day, not</u> every other day. (See included calendar). Our school is on a **six-day cycle**, and we attend on **odd days of the six-day cycle**.

If your child is <u>riding the bus</u> in the fall, the School Division Office will be aware (306-845-2150) once your registration has been processed.
